

SAVE LENHAM RAIL STATION



Maidstone Borough Council are considering closing our existing village railway station and moving it nearly 2 miles down the road to serve their proposed Heathlands 'new town' development.

Our rail station, village, and way of life is under threat!



The 'new town' would be home to more than 12,000 new residents swamping the existing Lenham community and placing significant strain on existing services such as GPs, schools, and local facilities. Heathlands does not sufficiently make provision for enough new services.



Construction traffic for the 'new town' would blight our roads and village for the next 30 years, with hundreds of lorry movements a day along with noise, dust and vibration.



Traffic on the A20 between Hollingbourne M20 J8 and Charing is predicted to increase by over 500% bringing the road to a standstill at many times of the day.



The 'new town', would end up connecting existing Lenham village with Lenham Heath hamlet infilling nearly 900 acres of green space between them with 5,000 homes.
